In order to participate in fire evolutions, each student is expected to have prior basic hose handling and firefighting training, as well as provide their own protective clothing (including helmet, turnout coat, boots, and gloves). All gear must be NFPA compliant. Bunker pants and FF boots are required. Long-sleeved shirts and full-length pants MUST be worn under turnout gear. **SCBA is made available** on Brayton Fire Training Field® for exterior firefighting. Recharging is available through the fire training facilities for all firefighting evolutions.

Fire Grounds

Actual firefighting is conducted at the TEEX Brayton Fire Training Field®, College Station, Texas. You will be training in simple and complex, small and large, realistic fire evolutions.
